

## Rose Bud Kisses

Rose buds made out of Hershey Kisses. A great gift for Mother's Day

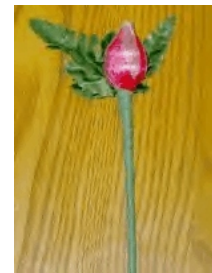
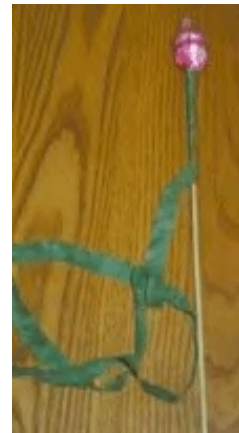


### Items needed:

Hot glue gun & hot glue, floral tape (available at Wal\*Mart, or any craft store), wooden skewers (available at grocery stores), silk leaves--your choice, Hershey Kisses--silver, gold, or colored (available on select holidays), plastic wrap--your choice of colors: if using colored kisses, use clear wrap, if using silver or gold kisses, you may want to use colored plastic wrap.



### How to make:



1. Poke the pointed end of a skewer into the tip of a kiss.
2. Hot glue another kiss on top of the kiss on the skewer. You only need a small dab of hot glue.
3. Wrap a square piece of plastic wrap **tightly** around the two kisses, wrapping it down the skewer **tightly** so it looks like the 4th picture above.
4. Wrap floral tape around skewer, starting at the base of the kisses all the way to the end of the skewer.
5. Cut two leaves off of the bunch, and floral tape onto the stick in the same manner as you did with the skewer. You do not need to floral tape all the way down when attaching the leaves. Just go about an inch below the bottom of the leaves.
6. Bunch together, tie with a ribbon and put in a vase.
7. You can cut the skewers in half for "short stem" roses, or leave them long for "long stem".
